The following year in June 1998, he was ordained to Christian Ministry at the Fountain Baptist Church by the Middlesex Central Baptist Association of New Jersey. In May 2013, he earned the Doctor of Ministry degree with emphasis on Congregational Growth and Development from the Theological School of Drew University, Madison, New Jersey.

He has held positions of leadership in a number of professional and community service organizations. He served as president of the board of the Summit Family Service Association; member of the board of SAGE, Inc.; an officer and member of the board of the National Black MBA Association, and is currently a member of the Board of Trustees for the New Brunswick Theological Seminary. He is currently engaged in other ministries that benefit people domestically and in various countries on the continent of Africa.
